

# 2024 Alabama Commodity Wreath Contest

## WHO MAY ENTER

1. To be eligible to participate in this program, an individual must be an Alabama Farmers Federation (ALFA Farmers) Member.
2. County winners may be determined by means of a county contest conducted and approved by that county.
3. The family members of employees of the Alabama Farmers Federation or ALFA Companies will not be eligible for this contest.
4. The first-place winner selected during the Alabama Farm and Land Expo, will not be eligible to compete the year immediately following.
5. The designer/maker of the wreath or a county designee can register the wreath at the State event. The person whose name is entered as the participant must be present during the Women's Division Luncheon at the Alabama Farm and Land Expo.

## HOW TO ENTER

1. Counties are encouraged to host a Commodity Wreath event spotlighting one of the following Commodities: **Bee and Honey; Beef; Catfish; Cotton; Dairy; Forestry; Greenhouse, Nursery and Sod; Hay and Forage Crops; Horticulture; Meat Goat and Sheep; Peanuts; Pork; Poultry; Soybeans; Wheat and Feed Grains; Wildlife and Equine.**
2. Wreaths should be decorated spotlighting only one commodity.
3. Minimum size for wreaths is 24" in diameter and a maximum size of 36" in diameter once decorated.

## STATE CONTEST, AWARDS AND JUDGING

1. The State Contest will be hosted at the ALFA Farmers Farm and Land Expo.
2. The Wreath winners will receive the following cash awards:

First Place	\$150.00
Second Place	\$100.00
Third Place	\$75.00

## WREATH SCORING GUIDE (Possible 80 pts total)

Does the wreath spotlight a specific commodity	40 pts
Power to attract and hold attention	20 pts
Uniqueness	20 pts
